



Freeport, Ill. — Edward C. Rafferty, 87, of Freeport passed away on Sunday, June 10, 2012, at FHN Memorial Hospital, with his family by his side.

Edward was born on Feb. 19, 1925, in Freeport, the son of Harold and Laura (Arbogast) Rafferty.
